
The complainant filed an appeal petition to Review Panel-4 of the Bangladesh Public Procurement Authority(BPPA) as per Rule 56 of the Public Procurement Rules 2008 (PPR 2008) wherein he stated that his company Techo Drugs Ltd participated in an open tender(Lots 1, 2 and 3) floated by the Logistics and Supply Unit of the Directorate General of Family Planning for Procurement of 45 million Cycles Oral Pill(3rd Generation) under Package No. FSD/GD-04 and became the lowest responsive bidder. While invoking the grounds for his appeal he stated that the Procuring Entity(PE) rejected the bid proposal submitted by his company even though it was compliant with the conditions set out in the tender documents.


He lodged complaints to the PE and Head of Procuring Entity (HOPE) on 14.03.2024 and 21.03.2024. Having got no remedies, he lodged complaints to the Secretary, Medical Education and Family Welfare Division on 28.03.2024. Here again, he did not get any remedies. Then he preferred this appeal seeking interventions from the review panel.

Hence it is ordered that-

Both parties be advised to wait till the disposal of the writ petition by the Hon'ble High Court. The security money deposited by the complainant be refunded.
